What is CIY:MOVE?

"CIY: MOVE is a 5-day high school event held all over the country designed to amplify the call of Christ on students' lives to become Kingdom Workers. Students currently in 8th-12th grade will be able to attend. This conference boasts interactive worship, dynamic preaching, small group study and community building. It's an all-inclusive event providing food, lodging, recreational activities and an amazing program."

This Years Theme: The Rest of Your Life

Do you feel pressure to measure up? To be the best? To try harder, work longer, never let up? Does all your striving, all your efforts to keep up, to stand out, only lead to being tired, exhausted, burnt-out, and weary? If so, then Jesus has something He wants you to hear... "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Join us this summer and let Jesus give you the REST of your life - for the rest of your life.

Where will we be?

The whole conference will be housed at **the Biola University Campus**. Our large group gatherings, activities, lodging, and meals will all be **on campus**. We will be **staying in dorms** on the campus. There are suite-style rooms with 2 rooms connected by a bathroom, as well as some traditional style dorms, with each room opening to the hallway and sharing a community bathroom. **Boys and girls will stay in separate dorms.** Everything is within walking distance of the dorms including dining halls and restaurants, outdoor and indoor recreation, and large group gathering halls.

How will we get there? When will we be back?

We will be traveling in 15-passenger vans. Biola is located about 7.5 hours away from Grace Church, so we will be leaving at 6am (sorry) the morning on June 23rd in order to arrive at to Biola on time (check-in starts at 1pm, dinner at 5pm). We will be back on Friday around 5pm. Check-out for CIY is at 8am on June 28th. We will eat breakfast in the morning there, get in the vans and head home, stopping for lunch midway.

What will my student be doing?

A typical day includes...

- Meals: On the school property in the dining hall.
- Sessions: With worship, teaching, and interactive games.
- **Small Groups:** Led by leaders attending with our groups, specifically crafted and equipped with materials by CIY.
- Afternoon Recreation: Sports, assorted campus activities, tournaments (dodgeball, basketball, soccer, ultimate frisbee), etc.
 - As well as regular rec activities, CIY encourages every group to take that Wednesday to do a large activity together. Therefore, Wednesday our group will take the entire afternoon (after the morning session) spending time at Knotts Berry Farm.
- **Daily Workshops:** (for three of the days) With anyone from worship leaders, emcees or the morning speaker. New workshops offered each day for diverse interests.

Who is taking my student?

We try to maintain a staffing ratio of one adult leader for every 5-7 students. CIY has strict policies for adult leaders with student's safety in mind. Each leader must complete a background check and successfully complete an approved Abuse Awareness Training Module.

Other FAQ's

What is the phone and electronics policy?

CIY does not have a specific cell-phone policy. In some instances, CIY will even create opportunities designed for students who have phones with them (i.e. trivia games, small group activities). However, if a students phone becomes a distraction OR is being used inappropriately, the leaders of the trip have permission to confiscate the phone.

Along with the phone policy, as with any of our trips, we do not allow any type of gaming system, tablet, or laptop allowed with the student. Also, headphones are NOT allowed on the trip. For any questions about headphones, please talk to me.

Can I, as the parent, go on this trip?

We seek out leaders in Student Ministry who desire to disciple your students <u>alongside you</u>, the parents. With this mission in mind, we recognize that Summer trips are an amazing opportunity for leaders to connect with students in a unique way that is much harder to achieve on any given group night. For this reason, we try and offer up our limited adult leader slots to already serving leaders.

So to answer the question, yes. But we would prefer to fill the slots with already serving leaders first. :) If you're a parent and you'd like to go, please talk to me and I can reserve a spot in the case that we need extra leaders.

- Snacks (optional) | \$20
 - For those vanilla lattes in the morning or just craving some Doritos at midnight! There are coffee and food options on campus.
- Souvenirs (optional) | \$30
 - Your student will get a shirt included in the trip price. But that bobble head is on their own.

Note: Please don't send your child with more than \$200 cash. It is easily lost, and your student is 100% responsible for all the money they are carrying.

Cancellation and Refunds

Scholarship options/financial discounts

We know that by asking your student(s) to participate in this trip, it will be a sacrifice of both time and money. We have worked hard to make this trip as affordable as possible, and want to do everything in our power to help find a way for your student to go. Early-Bird

• One of the <u>most helpful</u> things you can do to help me plan for a trip this big is to sign up as soon as possible. Because of this, I am offering a \$50 discount to any student who registers TODAY (February 4, 2024).

Launch

- Launch offers a great way to get discounts on camp. Below is a breakdown of the discounts offered based on how many points a student has (note: a student has until May 1 to accumulate points).
 - 1,500 points | \$50
 - 3,000 points | \$150
 - 4,500 points | \$250
 - 6,000 points | \$300

• "I have multiple kids" discount

 If you have multiple kids going to Summer trips this year (this includes both middle school and high school), you qualify for \$25 off/student. Just use the code "TONS-OF-KIDS" when you register.
