

## When, where, and who?

### This Years Theme: I AM

Who is, I AM? Jesus describes Himself in the New Testament in so many different ways. Jesus uttered numerous statements like, "I am the Way, the Truth, and Life", "I am the Vine, you are the branches", "I am the Bread of Life", "I am the Good Shepherd", or "I am the Light of the World". But what do these even mean? And what do these statements mean for us?

This year, we want to explore these "I am" statements, and how when we understand these statements about Jesus, we can better understand ourselves, and our relationship with the Son of God, the great I AM.

### Where will we be?

The camp will be held at **Emmanuel Pines Christian Camp in Prescott, AZ.** Our large group gatherings, activities, lodging, and meals will all be **at camp**. Lodging is in cabins.

### How will we get there? When will we be back?

We will be traveling in 15-passenger vans. Emmanuel Pines is located about 4 hours away from Grace Church, so we will be leaving at 1p on Sunday, June 2nd and will be back on Thursday around 2pm. We will eat breakfast in the morning there.

# What will my student be doing?

A typical day includes...

- **Meals:** On the camp property in the dining hall.
- Sessions: With teaching, and interactive games.
- **Small Groups:** Led by leaders attending with our groups.
- Free Time Activities: The camp has things like basketball, disc golf, 9-square, low ropes courses, and more on the camp property for students to do with each other during free time.
- **Group Games:** We plan to spend time during the week doing large group games together.

# Who is taking my student?

We try to maintain a staffing ratio of one adult leader for every 5-7 students. If not already completed, each trip leader will be required to pass a background check and a meeting with Nate.

### Other FAQ's

# What is the phone and electronics policy?

We strongly encourage parents to have their students leave their cell phones at home. However, if a student brings their phone, and the phone becomes a distraction OR is being used inappropriately, the leaders of the trip have permission to confiscate the phone. If a student needs to get ahold of a parent for any reason, leaders will have phones with them for emergency.

Along with the phone policy, as with any of our trips, we do not allow any type of gaming system, tablet, or laptop allowed with the student. Also, headphones are NOT allowed on the trip. For any questions about headphones, please talk to me.

## Can I, as the parent, go on this trip?

We seek out leaders in Student Ministry who desire to disciple your students <u>alongside you</u>, the parents. With this mission in mind, we recognize that Summer trips are an amazing opportunity for leaders to connect with students in a unique way that is much harder to achieve on any given group night. For this reason, we try and offer up our limited adult leader slots to already serving leaders.

So to answer the question, yes. But we would prefer to fill the slots with already serving leaders first. :) If you're a parent and you'd like to go, please talk to me and I can reserve a spot in the case that we need extra leaders.
